

TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2024-2025

Associate in Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Middle Grades Education

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associate in Arts (AA) at Maysville Community and Technical College (MCTC) and leads to the Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Middle Grades Education at Northern Kentucky University (NKU).

Applying to the MCTC2NKU Program

Students can apply to participate in the pathway program by completing the online application on the NKU transfer webpage. Students must be enrolled in at least six credit hours at MCTC, enrolled in an associate degree program, plan to transfer to NKU, and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA at MCTC.

Degree Requirements for MCTC

1) Completion of minimum 60 credit hours, 2) minimum cumulative GPA 2.0, 3) minimum of 15 credit hours earned at the institution awarding the degree, 4) cultural studies course, 5) demonstration of digital literacy, and 6) college success requirement.

Admission Requirements to NKU

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU.

In addition, students must meet the following requirements for admission into Education. Courses in parentheses are MCTC course equivalents.

A minimum overall GPA of 2.75

A minimum grade of "B" in CMST 101 (COM 181) and ENG 102 (ENG 102)

A minimum grade of "C" in all other pre-admission courses and required EDU and EDS courses which include EDU 300 (EDP 202), EDU 305 (EDU 201), EDU 313 (EDU 204), and EDS 360 (EDP 203).
